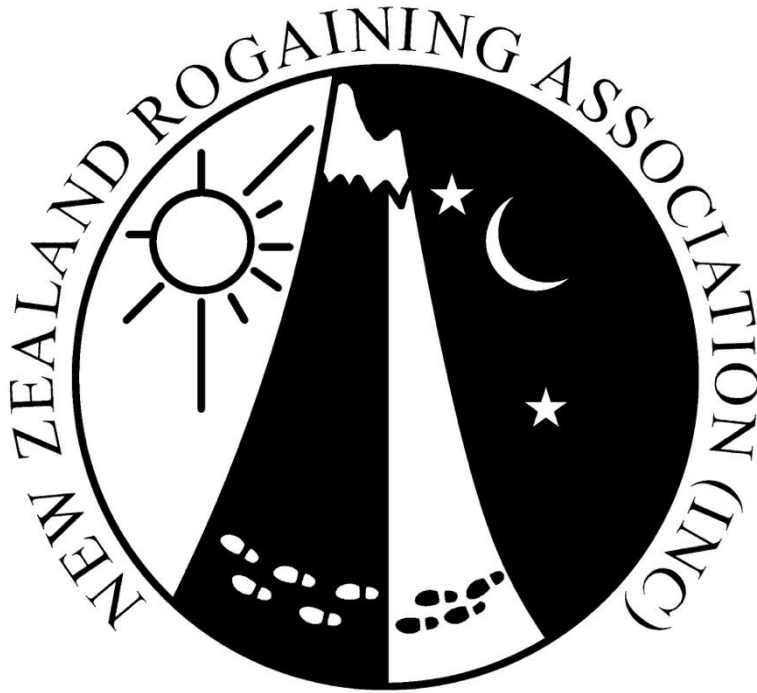

Association Information

Legal name of Association

Type of entity and legal basis
